2. Chief DiFava from MIT Police

Please look at him as someone here as an adviser, not in an official capacity. Been at MIT 6 years; 28 years with State Police; Runs 61 officers. Boston guy; knows Boston police and fire. Your neighbors have power and connections, might not be hesitant to make noise and call the city of Boston. Boston is in charge. As dorms in Boston, fraternities are not in the realm of the 4th amendment. When a Boston police officer (BPD) comes to the house, it is not a situation where they need a warrant. They can inspect and you have to let them in. **DO NOT SAY “WHERE’S YOUR WARRANT.”** They don’t need one. Please ask the officer to identify him/herself, but ask nicely. Don’t try and make enemies. Boston does not have the registrations for the parties. Just follow the rules that you set for yourselves, because this is their city and they know where the parties are. **97% of MIT police work is service (3% crime). Please call the MIT Police because they are here to help you.** They might not be able to bail you out, but they can at least soften the blow. Sergeants will respond to MIT Police calls from fraternities whenever possible. Supervisors are always on duty. There will be great cooperation with the BUPD. Please get to know your neighbors so that they are less likely to call on you and cause trouble. Let them know you are good guys (not Animal House guys). **617-253-1212**
