- Ability to reserve rooms and spaces on campus, including Kresge Oval, the barbecue pits, classrooms, Johnson Athletic Center, the MIT Chapel, etc.
- Ability to setup an MIT-internal account to take advantage of internal service for billing, and other services that the Student Activities Finance Office offers.
- One free full-page advertisement in *The Tech* each academic year.

ASA recognition for fraternities does not allow them to obtain office or bulletin board space, or UA or GSC funding.

To become ASA recognized, a fraternity must:

- Submit the attached startup form.
- Submit a copy of the fraternity's bylaws / constitution.
- Have a signed no-hazing pledge on file with the FSILG office for the current academic year.
