This letter is to notify you of the resolution of a report filed by the MIT Police regarding the night of May 5th, 2018. According to the report, on the night in question officers arrived at Chi Phi due to an anonymous complaint reporting a loud party on the roof with twenty plus people. This incident raised the possibility that Chi Phi may have violated the IFC Risk Management Policy, MIT Mind and Hand Book, and IFC Risk Management policies below:

While it is within your rights to use your roof while following occupancy regulations and for occasions other than social events, others in the community may not know this and may file complaints as they did in this instance.
