Dear Ben,

This letter is to notify you of the resolution of a report filed by the MIT Police on the night of May 24th, 2018. The incident involved alleged violations to the IFC Risk Management Policy.

On the night in question, officers arrived at the Delta Kappa Epsilon house following a citizen complaint and noticed cases of beer in a common area of the house. The officers also spoke to two underage members of Delta Kappa Epsilon who stated that they had been drinking alcohol. As a result, the IFC Judicial Committee finds Delta Kappa Epsilon responsible for the following violation:

IFC Risk Management Policy

III. Control of Alcohol

D. Alcohol should not be served to any individual who does not have a proper wristband, whose hand has been marked as an underage guest, or who is not of the age of 21.

This determination will not result in sanctions and will remain solely as a letter to file. The IFC Judicial Committee may consider this letter when deciding on future allegations against Delta Kappa Epsilon within the timespan permitted in the Judicial Committee Bylaws. I encourage you to keep alcohol out of all public spaces when there is no registered social event to prevent a similar issue from happening again.
