Dear Michael,

This letter is to notify you of the resolution of a report submitted by the MIT Police regarding an incident on Saturday, November 18, 2017. The incident involved alleged violations of the IFC Risk Management Policy.

On the night in question, MIT Police officers noted groups of people leaving the house of Phi Beta Epsilon. The President of Phi Beta Epsilon stated that the event was being shut down following the discovery that the event had been registered incorrectly. Officers remained outside the house until the crowd cleared without incident.

Accordingly, based on the complaint, the IFC Judicial Committee finds Phi Beta Epsilon responsible for violating the IFC Risk Management Policy's requirements for registering social events on November 18, 2017. This determination will not result in sanctions and will remain solely as a letter to file. The IFC Judicial Committee may consider this letter when deciding on future allegations against within the timespan permitted in the Judicial Committee Bylaws.
