Dear Trevor,

This letter is to notify you of the resolution of a report submitted by the MIT Police regarding an incident on Wednesday, September 13, 2017. The incident involved alleged violations to the MIT Mind and Handbook's Disorderly Conduct.

MIT Police officers arrived multiple times on the night in question to respond to complaints of loud noise at Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. They observed loud noise and music, and on returning to the house a second time, they instructed the fraternity to close the event. After the police's second arrival, Sigma Alpha Epsilon and all other parties present complied with the officers' requests, ending the event without further incident.

Accordingly, based on the complaint, the IFC Judicial Committee finds Sigma Alpha Epsilon responsible for violating the MIT Mind and Handbook's Disorderly Conduct policy on September 13, 2017. This determination will not result in sanctions and will remain solely as a letter to file. The IFC Judicial Committee may consider this letter when deciding on future allegations against Sigma Phi Epsilon within the timespan permitted in the Judicial Committee Bylaws.
