Dear David,

This letter is to notify you of the resolution of a report filed by the MIT Police regarding the night of April 27th, 2019. According to the report, on the night in question an MIT Police officer arrived at Sigma Nu and observed a line and loud music, as well as potential of too many people in attendance. This incident raised the possibility that Sigma Nu may have violated the following policies from the MIT Mind and Hand Book and FSILG Social Events Policy.

Guest Management

After reviewing your response and discussing the confusion regarding registration numbers with the FSILG Office and MIT Police, I have decided to resolve this case administratively. Based on the information provided in your response and in the police report, I have found Sigma Nu responsible for the Guest Management policy in the FSILG Social Events Policy. With regards to the disorderly conduct charge, we found it more likely than not that Sigma Nu was not responsible for the noise, but still advise to be conscious of this during events.

This finding of responsibility will be recorded as an organizational letter to file, which is considered a warning from MIT that Sigma Nu's behavior in this situation violated Institute expectations. This warning should prompt your house to reflect on this incident and the behavior. Please note that this letter to file does not directly impose any loss of privileges on Sigma Nu. However, if you are involved in any type of misconduct in the future, this letter will be considered in determining how your case should be heard and during sanctioning.
