NARRATIVE

On 4/15/18 at approximately 0047 hours I, Officer Schroeder, while assigned to the West Car(Car #290) was dispatched to 515 Beacon Street for a noise complaint. Dispatch stated the complaint was received from BUPD.

Upon arrival to 515 Beacon I didn't hear any noise coming from inside. I spoke with the residents inside the building and didn't hear any noise at all. As I exited the building I could hear noise coming from across the street at 526 Beacon Street. I arrived at the address and could hear the music coming from inside and could see several people gathered on the first floor. It should be noted that 526 Beacon Street houses an MIT fraternity(Theta Tau). I spoke to parties at the front door and they explained they were hosting a food event registered for Campus Preview Weekend. I asked them to turn down the music and one party I was speaking with left to turn it down. I continued to speak with the others at the front door when I heard the music come back on after it had initially stopped after my first instruction. I stepped inside with the person at the front door and yelled to have the music shut off and instructed all parties inside that didn't reside in the building to leave.

I spoke with fraternity President and informed him the event was shut down due to the continuous loud music. apologized for the noise and indicated that the music had turned back on accidentally as they were attempting to shut off the system. I explained to him that the music should not have been at the initial level in the first place and if they were going to host an event with music it had to be registered properly as an FSILG event. agreed to remain quiet for the night.
